


Age Distribution in Illinois Prisons, Illinois Population, and the U.S. Population




Prison Population Makeup and Age - How did we get here?


- Iron Law of Prison prison population is a function of admissions and length of stay
 - Admissions function of crime control policies, technical violation policies, sentencing, and broader population changes
 - Length of stay (LOS) long sentences, mandatory supervised release requirements, and/or requiring "Truth in Sentencing"
- Are trends moving in different directions or magnitude by age?








Illinois Prison Population by Age Group and Offense Type





Arrest Counts and Rates by Age Group – Unique Arrests




Arrest and Guilty Disposition Rates by Age Group












Comparison of First-Time Admissions vs. Prior Incarcerations Illinois Prison Admissions in FY2000 and FY2024

Nationwide Burglary Arrest Rates Birth Cohort and Age




