Eligibility in Resentencing

DRAFT eligibility recommendation

Chairman Marc Salone

Petitioners must meet two criteria to be eligible for sentence modification:

- (1) The petitioner must be serving an aggregate sentence of at least 20 years; and
- (2) The petitioner must have served at least 10 years of their sentence.

DRAFT procedural recommendation

Chairman Marc Salone

A petition for resentencing may be initiated by the prosecuting attorney, the Illinois Department of Corrections, a member of the judicial branch who has overseen proceedings involving the individual serving such sentence, or defense counsel.

DRAFT procedural recommendation

Where a petition for a reduction in a sentence has been denied, the petitioner may not file a successive petition until at least three years have elapsed after the date the petition was denied.
