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
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
Adult Felony Trends in Illinois, 2010-2022

SPAC's first general trends report showing a broad look at felony arrests, guilty dispositions, sentences, and prison usage

- Data sources
 - Criminal History Record Information (CHRI)
 - o Automated Disposition Reporting (ADR) extracts
 - o Circuit Clerk electronic data
 - o IDOC admissions, population, and exit data
- Timeline of significant events
- Data presented as both raw numbers and percentages in the report in graphs and tables with some narrative description







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Units of Analyses

Arrests

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- o CHRI data
- o Hierarchy most severe felony class charge and offense type
- Guilty Dispositions and Sentences
 - o CHRI, ADR, and Cook Circuit Clerk Data
 - o Convictions and Withheld Judgements
 - Convictions finding of guilt and judgement entered
 - Withheld Judgements finding of guilt but judgement is not entered if court requirements are satisfied
 - o Same hierarchy as arrests
- · Prison admissions, population, and exits
- o IDOC Planning and Research Extract Data
- IDOC establishes holding offense which is the sentence that has the longest period of incarceration




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Race/Ethnicity Adjustments

- IDOC race is self-reported and allowed Hispanic as a race category through entire timeframe of the report
- Hispanic added as a race option to CHRI in the mid-2010s
- SPAC used a technique called Bayesian Improved Surname Geocoding (BISG) to apply corrections to race in the non-IDOC data
- o Use race from IDOC if a match existed
- Otherwise, use BISG to estimate the most probable race/ethnicity from an individual based on combination of surname and county of arrest and the demographic makeup of the surname within the county.
- SPAC's ability to implement this in the future will depend on availability of PII information in our CHRI data access
